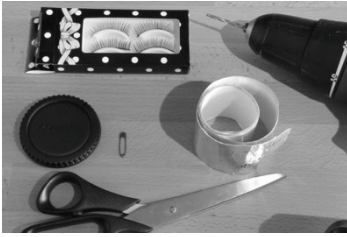


# Making an Eye Lash Pinhole lens for a DSLR

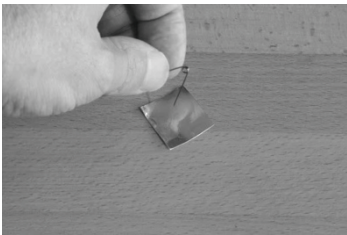


You will require;

Camera body cap (this is the cover which comes with all new cameras),  
Metal Duct Tape (or kitchen foil and cellotape),  
False Eye Lashes,  
3mm drill, scissors,  
Safety Pin or needle.

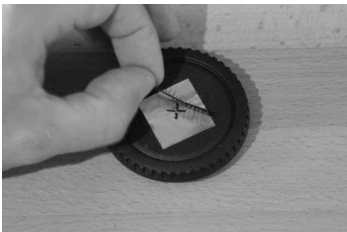
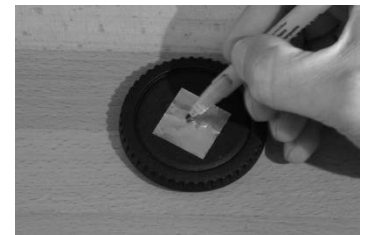
Drill a 3mm hole in the centre of the body cap.  
Clean up well.

It is really important to make sure there is no dust left as this will get onto the camera sensor.



Cut a 20mm square of metal Duct Tape.  
Make a pin hole in the centre with a safety pin.  
The smaller the hole the sharper the image will be.

Stick the square of Duct Tape onto the the Body Cap.  
Be careful to line up the pin hole with the 3mm hole  
Mark the centre of the pin hole with a marker pen.



Stick the false eye lashes above and below the pin hole.  
The exact position will determine how the final image looks. Experiment with moving the lashes when you are shooting.

The Completed Eye Lash pinhole lens.  
Remove the normal lens from the DSLR and replace with the Sun Lash Pinhole Lens.



Set your camera to manual mode.  
Recommended setting:  
Auto White Balance.  
ISO, less than 800.

Go out and find the sun.  
Be carefull not to look directly into the sun.  
Use the screen rather than the view finder.  
Experiment with shutter speeds and have fun.
